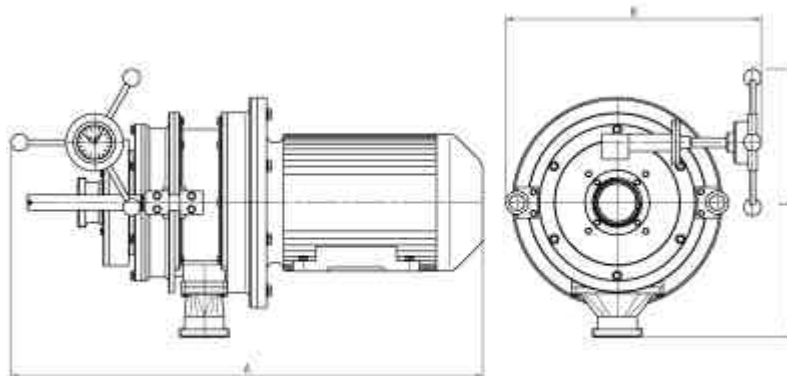
Wet grinding with unbeatable advantages
